NSI came into existence in 1951 by founder members Late Dr. Jacob Chandy (Neurosurgeon), Dr. Baldev Singh (Neurologist) from C.M.C hospital, Vellore and Dr. S.T Narasimhan (Physician and Electro physiologist) and Late Dr. B Ramamurthi (Neurosurgeon) from Madras Medical College & Hospital.

In 1979, a nucleus of association of Neuro- nurses in India (as associate members of NSI) was created at national institute of Mental Health and Neuroscience (NIMHANS) DURING 29th annual conference of NSI and decided to hold Nurses Conference of the Society. This annual 'Satellite Conference of Neuro- nurses of India" provided a forum for Indian Neuro- nurses to exchange views on how to set high standards of care for nurses in this speciality and broaden their horizon of knowledge and practice.
